4-H members (age 9 to 18) earn points by reading or performing reading-related community service between **March 15 and June 15**. Emphasis is given to reading material related to the member's project area. *Participants earning a minimum of 25 points will receive a ribbon.* Points are awarded as follows:

- Each book related to your project area. 5 points
- Each book not related to your project area. 3 points
- Magazine or Internet article related to your project area. 1 point
- Each Chapter from a textbook related to your project area. 1 point
- Community service bonus. 2 points

Participants can earn community service bonus points by reading to someone in need. (Preschooler, elderly, visually impaired, etc.) If the reading material is age/ability appropriate, the bonus points are in addition to points earned by the material. If, for instance, a teenager reads Dr. Seuss to a preschooler, only the 2 community service points are earned. 2 bonus points can also be earned for every hour participants volunteer in a literacy program, at a library or perform community service which relates to the reading material.

Cloverbuds do not earn points. They participate in the CLOVER program by reading 5 books or by having 5 books read to them. (The ability to read is not necessary for participation in the CLOVER program.)
