

**Important Changes for 2018:**

- In the old rows, spots and drives have been widened causing a loss of camping spots in each row, this means campers that do not fit have been moved. (West Lot)
- Each camping unit (and associated tents / pop ups, etc.) must not encroach onto the fire lane. Again if your camper doesn't fit, it will have to be moved to another spot.
- A new fence has been installed between the West lot and the fairgrounds.
  - Anyone entering the fairgrounds from the West lot must present a valid ticket, wristband, and/or handstamp to enter the fair gates anytime they pass thru.
- Gates to the Campgrounds will be unlocked/open at all times (West Lot)
- Camp spots have been renumbered (West Lot)
- There will be no trashcans in the camping area. You must take your trash to the designated dumpster. (West Lot)
- Sewer pumping remains available at a fee of \$40 per pump-out. Contact the Office a day in advance.
- Golf Carts MAY be permitted for a fee and must carry appropriate insurance. Fee will be \$100 for the week. Does not include the cart.
  - There will be separate rules forthcoming on Carts. Availability of permits may be limited.
  - This remains subject to Board Approval.
- Port-a-Pots will be available inside the West Lot campgrounds
- For campers in the newer spots, you may need an appropriate extension cord to reach the outlets. Please be aware.
- Northside Changes
  - These spot numbers will not change this year
  - Camp Spot #170 on the North side has been eliminated
  - Campers must fit within their spaces – cannot be on the drive.
  - Golf Carts are not permitted for campers using the North Spaces (unless you are a Fair Board Director or other exhibitor who has a contract for such use)
    - Spot #'s 171 – 205

**Load-in:**

- **Campers must have paid their camping fee(s) in full to be allowed to set their camper.**
- Campers in the West Lot will be given a NEW Camping Permit Card.
- Campers will be permitted to load in: Friday August 24 (5pm – 9pm) and Saturday thru Monday August 27 (8am – 8pm). All Campers must be set by 8pm on August 27.
- Please be courteous to your neighbors and others assisting by only bringing in your campers on Friday and Saturday. This will get people in and out quicker.
- Please enter via Wertz Avenue only – 7th Street Entrance.
- You are responsible for the placement of your camper on your camp spot.
- Campers must be within their designated space
- Limited help will be available to move in campers. If you need assistance, please find the campground supervisor or contact the office.
- You will be responsible for any damage to any property, including the fairgrounds, that you cause as a result of load-in/load-out.

## 2019 Changes:

- This is very likely the last year for double spots. (Each spot will have to have a camping unit – no extra spots for tents, etc.)
  - No open spots will be sold until after the reservation period ends in 2019. Campers wanting to make a change or new campers will be put on a waiting list. This will be first come first served with the appropriate deposit being made.
- All campers on the North side of the barns will move to the west lot in 2019.
- In 2019, Camping units will need to be appropriate size for the spot that is rented. As a general rule, the camper unit must occupy no less than the total length of the spot less 10 feet. In other words, if the spot is 40' long, the camper must be at least 30' in length to be in that spot.
  - Reservations for 2019 must include the correct length (hitch to bumper) to be considered a valid reservation.
  - We will make every effort to keep parties together, so you will need to note who you want to camp beside.
  - Fair board will move campers as necessary to accommodate.
- We continue to investigate new changes to the camp grounds to make it better.

**All other rules pertaining to camping as previously provided continue to apply. Theft, vandalism, and unlawful acts will not be tolerated and will be turned over to the appropriate authorities to prosecute.**

**Reminder:** *Unruliness or Poor Attitude: Campers (and family/guests) who become unruly or belligerent with any Director of the Stark County Agricultural Society, may be permanently evicted from the fairgrounds.*
