

2018 GOLF CARTS AND GATOR-STYLE (UTV) VEHICLES REGULATIONS for JR. FAIR PARTICIPANTS/CAMPERS

NO ATV'S WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS DURING FAIR WEEK. ATV'S INCLUDE THREEWHEELERS, FOUR-WHEELERS AND MOTORCYCLES. GOLF CARTS AND GATOR-STYLE (UTV'S) VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED, BUT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All golf carts/UTV's/Gators must be issued a permit by the fair office, which cost \$100 each. The permit must be displayed on the front of the cart at all times. If a cart does not have a permit it will be removed from the fairgrounds. Permits shall only be issued to Jr. Fair Campers and the Board has the right to limit the number of carts on the grounds at any time.
2. A certificate of insurance must be provided with coverage amounts of no less than \$500,000 for both personal injury and property damage. This certificate shall be on file with the Fair Office prior to the issuance of a permit and must state that your unit is covered off of your premises.
3. Only licensed drivers will be allowed to operate carts.
4. All carts will be operated in a safe and reasonable manner. Carts are not to be used during the quiet hours per the camping rules. Carts and UTV's shall operate at speeds not to exceed 10 mph.
5. Carts must be parked within your camping spot and not encroach onto the fire lane when at your campsite. In addition, carts must be parked in designated parking areas during the operating hours of the fair. Signs will be posted
6. Livestock supply deliveries shall be made prior to 10am. Carts should not be parked at or around the barns during the operating hours of the fair to permit the public access to these areas. Carts are not permitted beyond the marked areas of the fair (blue lines). Carts found in prohibited areas will be immediately confiscated for the remainder of the fair.
7. At no time during the fair shall any cart be permitted in the midway, by the grandstands or other areas outside of the permitted locations. (Note that this does not apply to operators who have properly obtained permits to access these areas. No Jr. Fair participant shall have such permit)
8. Carts are not permitted inside the fairgrounds during animal load-in or load-out.
9. During the operating hours of the fair, carts are only permitted to enter the grounds using either the south gate of the campgrounds or the 7th Street North gate by the horse barns.
10. These rules shall be enforceable by any Director of the Stark County Fair or any law enforcement officer.
11. Any violations of these rules will subject the cart owner to revocation of their permit, forfeiture of their permit and impoundment of their cart. Permits for cart usage can be granted and revoked at the sole discretion of the Fair Board without refund to the permit holder.
12. All permit holders agree to indemnify, release and hold harmless the Stark County Fair and the Stark County Agricultural Society from injuries, damages and other loss as a result from the use of the cart. Furthermore each permit holder is responsible for injuries, damages and loss to others and the fair property from use of such cart.
13. Unruliness or Poor Attitude: Permit holders (or drivers and passengers on carts) who become unruly or belligerent with any Director of the Stark County Agricultural Society, may be permanently evicted from the fairgrounds.
