2025 Department Rules and Guidelines:

Please read, proceed accordingly

- Entries are open to Stark County residents only.
- Entries deadline is Saturday August 9, 2025, at 5:00PM. All entries must be in the hands of the Fair office or via online entry.
- All rules defined in this document apply to ALL DIVISIONS in the ART HALL. Some divisions will have additional rules pertaining to that division only!
- ART HALL questions should be directed to Office@starkcountyfair.com. Include your name, phone number and question with your email. You will receive a call back or email as soon as possible.

EXTREMELY IMPORTANT: 2025 Entries

- **Membership Tickets (\$30) – Stark County Residents only. Unlimited entries. Seven-day Fair admittance. Memberships bought online must be picked up from the Fair Office. MEMBERSHIPS CAN NOT BE PURCHASED FOR OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS OR FRIENDS!**
- **YOUTH DIVISION-OPEN TO AGES 17 AND UNDER**
Youth Division Exhibitors are defined as any 4-H Member who has a pre-paid wristband OR a Youth who has purchased a \$8.00 Junior Exhibitor Pass.
- All entries must remain in place until specified pick-up dates and times.
- No entry will be released without Entry Claim Check or Membership/Exhibitor Ticket.
- All entries must be made in the name of the Owner, product of Exhibitor's skill and handicraft since 2024 Fair, unless specified by Division Rule.
- **No Exhibitor may make more than one (1) entry per Class.**

- Division rules must be followed, or entry will not be judged.
- The decision of the Judges will be final!
- **One entry per Class does not constitute First Place or Best of Show.**
- Judging is based on the merit and quality of the entry for competition. If a Judge deems no entries (multiple) in a particular Class are worthy of placement, that is the decision of the Judge and is acceptable. Judges are directed to note why their decision was as such.
- For your benefit, we reserve the right to sub-divide ANY of the Classes if too full. Sub-divided Classes will be judged as such, and premiums will be paid as such.
- All entries must be clean and in compliance with Division rules for display.
- **The Fair will use reasonable care, but will, under NO circumstances, be responsible for any loss or breakage which occurs.**
- Judging will not be open to the public.

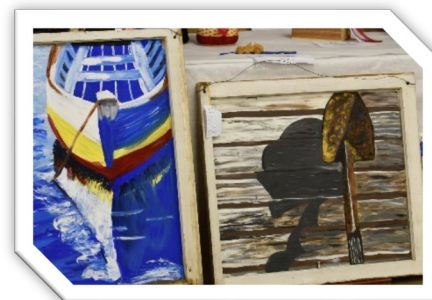

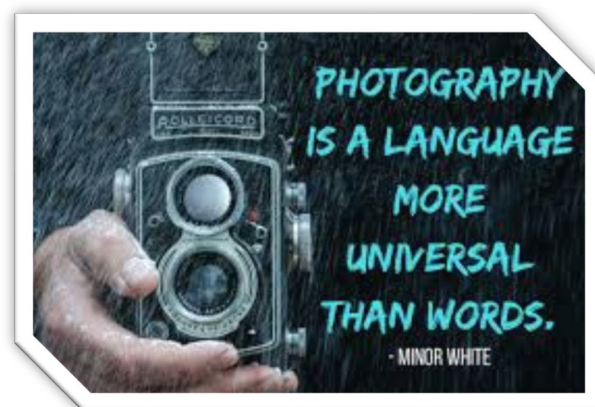

- Maximum Size of entry with mat 12"x14".
- The use of card stock or similar is recommended for backing to assure picture remains attached to matting.
- Please tape picture and card stock to mat securely.
- Please mark the back of photo TOP and BOTTOM.
- No additional hanging device is needed on the picture.
- No display of Business Cards or any other advertising.
