- All entries must remain in place until specified pick-up dates and times.
- No entry will be released without Entry Claim Check or Membership/Exhibitor Ticket.
- All entries must be made in the name of the Owner, product of Exhibitor's skill and handicraft since 2024 Fair, unless specified by Division Rule.
- No Exhibitor may make more than one (1) entry per Class.

- Division rules must be followed, or entry will not be judged.
- The decision of the Judges will be final!
- One entry per Class does not constitute First Place or Best of Show.
- Judging is based on the merit and quality of the entry for competition. If a Judge deems no entries (multiple) in a particular Class are worthy of placement, that is the decision of the Judge and is acceptable. Judges are directed to note why their decision was as such.
- For your benefit, we reserve the right to subdivide ANY of the Classes if too full. Subdivided Classes will be judged as such, and premiums will be paid as such.
- All entries must be clean and in compliance with Division rules for display.
