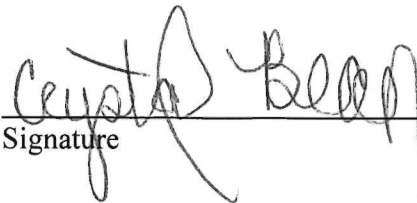

2025 JUNIOR FAIR AFFIDAVIT

The Ohio General Assembly has provided a subsidy to reimburse agricultural societies for junior fair activities held in the previous calendar year. In order qualify for these subsidies, an agricultural society shall:

1. Award junior fair premiums at that fair;

"Junior fair premiums" means the total amount reported on Row 9320 of the Auditors Report. More specifically:

1. Money paid by a society as awards to individual members or groups of members, of junior organizations for which the society provides awards in its annual premium list;
2. Money expended by a society for ribbons, banners, medals, achievement pins, trophies, or merchandise awarded to such members; and
3. Money expended by a society for trips awarded to junior organization members, or to leaders of such junior organizations.
