These are some of the expectations for the 2025 Stark County Junior Fair Royalty. Others may be added as necessary and will be provided in writing to all Royalty. If you are chosen for the 2025 Stark County Junior Fair Royalty or court, you will be responsible for the following:

- Be present and on time for the 2025 Stark County Junior Fair Royalty coronation (date & time provided at interviews)
- Attend all livestock auctions at the 2025 Stark County Fair for photos with Grand & Reserve Champions (schedule will be provided)
- Encouraged to attend as many livestock shows to help present ribbons.
- Attend Clothing and Extravaganza awards to help present awards.
- Attend coronation for 2026 Royalty at the 2026 Stark County Fair.
- Visit at least **10** local county fairs representing Stark County Junior Fair (hand out county pins provided by the Royalty Committee).
- Attend and participate in at least **5** community activities (parades, festivals, shows, homecomings, etc.)
- Visit at least **2** schools to present 2025 Stark County Junior Fair Royalty.
- Help the Royalty Committee gather at least 25 items for Swag Bags given to visiting Royalty. Give Swag Bags to visiting royalty and give visiting Royalty a tour of Stark County Fair.
- Communicate with the Royalty Committee of the activities you are attending and participating in.
- Responsibly representing the Stark County Fair and Junior Fair in all activities.
- Act in a professional manner at all times.
- Dress appropriately at all times (outfit, crown, sash, hat, shirt)
- Always use appropriate language
- Be professional on all social media.
- Provide your own travel to and from events.
- If you are under 18 years of age, provide a chaperone for all events.
- The Royalty Committee has the right to remove any Royalty that does not follow the written expectations at any time.
