

## **Auction Times Sept. 2 at 12:00pm start to Sept. 4<sup>th</sup> ending at 9:00pm**

### **Register to Bid**

The auction platform we will be using is from an Ohio company named Wendt. You must be 18 years and above to bid. Go to [juniorfairauctions.com](http://juniorfairauctions.com) and on the left side is Login/Register link create an account using your email and creating a password. Fill in your personal and contact information in your profile making sure you use a phone number that will receive a text with checking the agreement of terms and click blue register button. By visiting each tab at the top, you will be compiling more information. Under notifications, make sure you check both email and phone texting which will be used to notify you when you are outbid on the lot number(s) in your watch list. You will have to input a credit or debit card that will be used to verify information given matches and will not be used for payment. As you complete each tab, it will add up in red for 100% completion. The system will tell you if you are missing anything. Make sure you log out and log back in, so you are sure you are good to go. Also, look for other Junior Fair Auctions on the site to familiarize yourself with the setup. They may not be run as our auction is running, but you can see how things work and are setup.

### **Bidding Process**

You must be registered to bid. You can view the bidding but not bid if you are not registered. Go to [juniorfairauctions.com](http://juniorfairauctions.com) and log in with your email and password. Select our auction site - Stark County Junior Fair Livestock Auctions. We may have each species under their own site or one site with multiple links those Links are: Rabbits will have market rabbits and rabbit fryers, Poultry will have Market Turkeys, Market Ducks (a new Class) and Market Broilers. Dairy will have Market Dairy Steer and Carcass, Cheese and Dairy Beef Feeders. Goats will have Meat Market, Dairy Market, and Goat Milk Production Basket. Lambs will have Market Lamb, Carcass Lambs and Wool. Swine will have Market Hog and Carcass. Beef will have Market Beef and Carcass. There is a search box that you can put exhibitors name in and all animals they have will show.

Each lot number has a picture of an eye and if you have certain lots you want to watch you will be emailed and/or texted when bidding happens on this lot. This watch list maybe seen by choosing the link when you login on the left. You may cancel the lot on the watchlist by clicking on eye icon again. If you are winning the bid it will say that in green on the Lot. If you have been outbid it will tell you that also. You will be bidding in whole dollar amount for all species and each species might have a bid increment difference. This is a change as some species have sold by the pound in the past. You will have to look in the lot area for the buyback price to see if the lot has one. Please note that the buyback price will not be used to calculate your online bidding price. Your buyback price will reflect on your final invoice which will come from the Stark County Junior Fair Marketing Committee. With the buyback, committees have arranged to have the animal resold and you will pay the difference between resold bid and your bid.

#### **Remember to refresh often to have current bidding information.**

New to the auction this year is an ADD ON option. It is a monetary donation to the exhibitor without the transfer of ownership. This is a great way to assist exhibitors through financial donations. There are no bid retractions. All bids are non-cancellable once submitted. Our auction will be run as an auto extend racehorse finish where the bidding will keep going until 3 minutes in between bids the first hour after close 2 minutes the second hour, and 1 minute the third hour of no bidding. Auction then will be declared closed.

### **Multi Buyers of a Lot/ Donate to 4-Her after the Auction**

The Multi buyer bidding will work differently this year. We are suggesting that the group go together, but only **one person** does the bidding. In this packet is a form to fill out when the auction is closed to bidding and you have won the bid. We ask that you email or fax the completed form with listing the person that gets the processed meat and processor. The email is [starkcojfairmarketing@gmail.com](mailto:starkcojfairmarketing@gmail.com) or fax number is 330 452-0787. When this is

placed in the Stark County Marketing's pay system we will be able to invoice everyone their portion of the lot. Also if you missed the bid and would like the Junior Fair member to receive the additional monies let us know when we call to confirm your processor Saturday September 5<sup>th</sup>. We will be able to adjust your invoice with the added monies.

## Processor

You may mark your processor of choice in the any additional information the sale committee needs to know box. You will find processor in following pages. The Stark County Junior Fair Committees will be calling you Saturday morning to confirm if this is your processing. It is extremely important that the phone number you give during the registration process is a phone number that you can be reached on Saturday. If no processor is designated in the "Committee Needs to Know Box" and we are not able to get a hold of you, a processor will be selected for you at the discretion of the Marketing Committee.

## Payment

When all processor information has been completed and new buyer numbers have been assigned through the Stark County Marketing Payment system, we will input our Wendt auction bidding information into our system. This will take at least 24 hours. We hope to be able to accept online payments by Sunday afternoon. If you are not paying online, your invoice will be sent to address that Wendt received during registration. They should be mailed Tuesday or Wednesday. To pay online you will need your buyer number that is assigned out of the Stark County Marketing Committee Payment System and some personal information. There will be a processing fee on invoices not paid with cash or check. The website for credit card payment or if you want to look up your invoice is [pay.starkcountyjrfair.com/online/invoices/](http://pay.starkcountyjrfair.com/online/invoices/). You may also pay your invoice online with a credit card once you receive your invoice in the mail if you do not want to pay by cash or check. If you wish to pay by cash, please contact Gail Oberlin to make arrangements to pay by cash. Please do not send cash in the mail. If you pay by credit card, you will be able to get a copy of your paid invoice for a receipt at the time of payment. If you pay by cash or check, the Marketing Committee will need to enter the details into the payment system before a paid invoice receipt will be ready.

## Terms and Conditions

You must be registered with Wendt to purchase. All purchases must be paid in full by 30 days after auction. Checks should be made to Stark County Junior Fair Marketing Committee. Any animal that is sold is not eligible to be shown by any exhibitor or 4-H/FFA member in any Junior Show in Ohio County, Independent, or State Fair. All animals that are sold will be released Monday September 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. All carcass animals will be standard cut. To help our processors out you are asked to call and provide them with your cut information. Our processors also request that you promptly pick up meat when ready. All poultry lots will have processing added to your bill. All buy back poultry will be donated to the Akron-Canton Food Bank under the buyer's name. Champions and Placings will not be **NOT** be notated on the lots because we have not had the judging at the time information has to be uploaded on the auction site. We will have a live streaming of shows and will be place show results on Facebook and the [starkcountyjrfair4-H.com](http://starkcountyjrfair4-H.com) website. If you do purchase a Grand or Reserve market animal, it must be slaughtered in Stark County or an adjoining county per State Testing Requirements/Law. The Stark County Junior Fair Marketing Committee and the Wendt Group are not responsible are the quality, speed, and accuracy of internet connections used by the service provider during the auction that may cause a lapse in time between submissions.
