2022 JUNIOR FAIR AFFIDAVIT

The Ohio General Assembly has provided a subsidy to reimburse agricultural societies for junior fair activities held in the previous calendar year. In order qualify for these subsidies, an agricultural society shall have:

- 1. Awarded junior fair premiums at that fair;
- 2. Submit to the director of agriculture a Junior Fair Report; and
- 3. Certify to the director of agriculture the total amount paid by the society for premiums for members of junior organizations.

"Junior fair premiums" means the total amount reported on Row 9320 of the Auditors Report. More specifically:

- 1. Money paid by a society as awards to individual members or groups of members, of junior organizations for which the society provides awards in its annual premium list;
- 2. Money expended by a society for ribbons, banners, medals, achievement pins, trophies, or merchandise awarded to such members; and
- 3. Money expended by a society for trips awarded to junior organization members, or to leaders of such junior organizations.
