Rules and Eligibility Guidelines:

- 1. Applicants must be <u>a current</u>, <u>enrolled</u> Stark County 4-H member, and a member for a minimum of three <u>consecutive</u> years and a <u>current high school senior</u>. There will not be 4-H Advisor College Scholarships.
- 2. Applicants must be pursuing, or planning to pursue a degree from an accredited two or more-year post-secondary institution.
- 3. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to apply.
- 4. Two copies of each item must be submitted. Application should be accompanied by high school transcripts and two letters of recommendation from responsible community members. Person should not be related to the applicant. This letter can include information regarding the applicant's 4-H participation, skills acquired through the 4-H program (leadership, communication, etc.) and involvement in the school and community.
- 5. An individual <u>member</u> in good standing can only receive a <u>Stark County 4-H College Scholarship</u> once, as a graduating senior.
- 6. Each year <u>up</u> to six 4-H youth college scholarships will be awarded, dependent upon funds available.
- 7. Applicants may participate in an interview with members of the Stark County 4-H Committee and community members. Scholarship selections will be presented at the Junior Fair Youth Awards Ceremony at the Stark County Fair Opening Ceremonies on Tuesday.
- 8. You may add additional pages to this application.
- 9. Applicant MUST provide university name/address and student ID number. ALL checks MUST be written and mailed directly to university for your scholarship, OSU and IRS Policy requirement, no exceptions.
