JUDGES

- 1. Judges are not permitted to serve on a committee in any class in which they are competing for a premium, and no person who is related to any competitor will be allowed to act as a member of any Awarding Committee. Vacancies in such committees should be referred at once to the Superintendent in Charge.
- 2. Judges will in no case, where there is no competition, award premiums for articles that are not meritorious.
- 3. Judges will take in to consideration the symmetry, early maturity, size, feeding and other circumstances connected with the animal they may judge, but should give no encouragement to over-feeding.
- 4. Judges shall permit no person to interfere in their examinations, or to be present at their deliberations. Any competitor in any manner interfering in such examination or deliberation will thereby forfeit any right he/she may otherwise have to premiums for animals or articles on exhibition.
